

## Exhibitor Rules for Langham Classic Car Show

### 1. Entry Criteria

The event is open to vintage, veteran and classic vehicles (registered before 1984). We will also accept selected modern classics (no longer in production), classic motorcycles and small classic commercial vehicles. No modern substitute allowed if entered vehicle fails to proceed. Entry is at the discretion of the organisers.

### 2. Vehicle Changes

If for any reason you need to make changes to your vehicle booking, please contact Peter Freeman at [p.freeman@langhamparishcouncil.co.uk](mailto:p.freeman@langhamparishcouncil.co.uk). You cannot change the vehicle entered without prior notification and acceptance of the organisers.

### 3. Vehicle Ownership

The entrant must be the legal owner of the vehicle or be authorised by the owner to be using the vehicle.

### 4. Vehicle License and MOT

Any modern classics registered after 1<sup>st</sup> April 1984 must be licensed and have a valid MOT certificate. These documents must be brought along on the day to show to the organisers prior to entry.

### 5. Insurance

By completing your vehicle entry form, you are agreeing that any person in charge of the vehicle entered into the event is covered by the appropriate insurance as required by law.

### 6. Entry on the Day

Entry may be refused if satisfactory evidence of the above documents cannot be produced upon request.

### 7. Display Bookings

Booking receipts are non-transferable.
